


# MMZO / ZLO PLAYA DE ORO INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

### Operational information:

**Operational hours:** Winter 1400-0200 UTC / Summer 1300-0100 UTC.

**Customs and Immigration:** During airport operational hours.

**Overtime:** Can be arranged 3 hours prior airport closure but only for big aircrafts such as GLEX, E190, B737, etc.

Fuel available: Avgas 100/130 (No fuel truck) & Jet A.

Fuel method of payment: Credit card, debit card, Uvair-World Fuel card or ASA release.

Catering: No catering services are available that meet business aviation standards such as quality or plating. If our customer is picking up passengers from an international destination, we recommend bringing the catering onboard as it will not be disposed if it's only a quick turn.

## MMZO / ZLO PLAYA DE ORO INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

### **Arrivals:**

- 1. Upon the aircraft arrival crew must follow ATC's commands to taxiing to the general aviation platform.
- 2. Crew and passenger passports will be taken by one of our staff representatives so they can be delivered to an immigration officer inside the general aviation building where all authorities are.
- 3. When all passengers deplane, customs and Immigration officers will come onboard the aircraft to make a quick revision, personnel from Mexican Army and National Guard will make other inspections outside the aircraft.
- Passengers must walk inside the general aviation building to make the CIQ (Customs, Immigration, and quarantine) processes. Luggage cannot be inspected without passenger's presence.
- 5. The whole procedure will take around 10-15 minutes, depends on how passengers may arrive.

#### Departures:

- Crew and passenger need to arrive at the general aviation facilities where passports will be taken by one of our staff representatives to hand them to an immigration officer.
- 2. The luggage will be taken inside for a quick inspection.
- 3. Once all revisions are finished, we will take the luggage to the aircraft and passengers may board the aircraft.
- 6. The whole procedure will take around 10-15 minutes, depends on how passengers may depart.
