

**Operational hours:** Winter 1200-0600 UTC / Summer 1100-0500 UTC.

**Customs and immigration:** During airport operational hours.

Fuel available: Avgas 100/130, Jet

### **Arrival**

- 1. Upon arrival, crew must follow ATC instructions for taxiing to General Aviation Apron through taxiways A or B depending on the arriving runway.
- 2. Crew and passenger passports will be asked by staff representative to take them to immigration and customs facilities.
- When all passengers deplane, customs, National Guard and agriculture officers will come onboard to make a quick inspection. Please remember that all luggage must be offloaded and food will be disposed.
- Passengers must walk inside the general aviation building to make the CIQ (Customs, Immigration and quarantine) processes. Luggage cannot be inspected without passenger's presence.
- Passengers can exit from General Aviation or from the FBO.
- 6. The whole process will take around 20-25 minutes.
- 7. The aircraft will towed to the FBO Mira.

### **Departure**

- 1. Crew and passenger passports will be asked by our staff representative to take them to immigration facilities as well as their luggage.
- 2. The luggage will be taken inside the x ray clearance due a brief security inspection.
- 3. The whole process will take around 20-25 minutes.

This process could present delays due that Customs & Immigration authorities have top priority for commercial operations.
